**FT. WALTON BEACH RECREATION CENTER TO REMAIN AS POLLING PLACE
FOR MARCH 17, 2020, PRESIDENTIAL PREFERENCE PRIMARY ELECTION**

The Ft. Walton Beach Recreation Center will remain a polling place for those residing in precincts 22 and 41 for the March 17, 2020, Presidential Preference Primary. Due to concerns over the novel coronavirus COVID-19, the Ft. Walton Beach Recreation Center at 132 Jet Dr NW, Ft. Walton Beach, 32548, will be closed to the non-voting public. Only voters who reside in precincts 22 and 41, as well as poll workers and staff from the Okaloosa County Supervisor of Elections office, will be permitted to enter the building. Again, for voters in precincts 22 and 41 in Okaloosa County, your polling place at the Ft. Walton Beach Recreation Center *has not* changed despite the City of Ft. Walton Beach announcing closures of city facilities. The facility is otherwise closed to the public for recreational use and will resume the same status as other City of Ft. Walton Beach facilities once the polls have closed on March 17, 2020.
