

NOTICE OF CANVASSING BOARD MEETINGS

Pursuant to Section 101.68(2)(a) Florida Statutes, the County Canvassing Board for the November 8, 2022, General Election, will convene at 10:00 am on Friday, October 14, 2022, to begin the canvassing and processing of the vote-by-mail ballots. All meetings will be held at the Supervisor of Elections Office, 302 N Wilson St, Suite 102, Crestview. Any voter who needs to update his or her signature must do so before the October 14, 2022, Canvassing Board meeting.

Vote-by-mail ballots will be available for public review beginning at 9:00 am on Friday, October 14, 2022; and one hour before any subsequent canvassing board meetings. Those requesting review can submit a request form found on our website at www.voteokaloosa.gov under public notices.

The County Canvassing Board consisting of Judge Mason, Judge Schlechter (alternate), County Commissioner Mel Ponder, and Supervisor Paul Lux will convene as follows to continue the canvassing and processing of the vote-by-mail ballots and oversee the conduct of the election:

Beginning at 2:00 pm on Tuesday, November 8, 2022, the County Canvassing Board will reconvene to continue the canvassing and processing of the vote-by-mail ballots and oversee the conduct of the election until activities are concluded on election night. The Board will reconvene at 10:00 am on Friday, November 11, 2022, to verify and process provisional ballots.

Beginning at 1:30 pm on Friday, November 18, 2022, the Board will reconvene to canvass and process overseas military vote-by-mail ballots and to certify Official Results. Immediately following the certification of the Official Results, the Board will randomly select the precincts to be audited in accordance with F.S. 101.591 and will reconvene at 10:00 am on Tuesday, November 22, 2022, to conduct the audit.

If any elector present at the canvassing believes any ballot is illegal due to defect apparent on the Voter's Certificate, that elector may file a protest **before** the ballot is removed from the mailing envelope. No tabulation or publication of results may be made before 7:00 pm on election day.
