### ***Your Vote Counts!***

Dear Voters,

We have prepared this Sample Ballot booklet to help guide you through the races you will be voting on in the **August 14<sup>th</sup> Primary** and to update you with any changes in laws or procedures that might have happened since the last time you voted.

This year there are six (6) Universal Primary Contests—Public Defender, Sheriff, Tax Collector, Superintendent of Schools, County Commission District 3, and County Commission District 5. ***These races are open to all voters regardless of party affiliation.*** There is no run-off for these races either, so whoever receives the highest number of votes will win on August 14<sup>th</sup>.

While there is a ballot style for every voter—Republican, Democrat, or minor/no party—not everyone will see all the races presented in this booklet. There are several closed primary races and a municipal referendum in Destin. There are also several precincts that are split by a State legislative race, so please make careful note of those races.

Some important things to remember:

- **Have you moved recently?** You can save yourself a lot of time if you let us know before election day. You can make your address change by phone, e-mail, or in person at our nearest office. Certain voters who fail to update their address before election day may be required to vote a Provisional Ballot. Remember, it is a felony to vote in a precinct other than which you reside.
- **Did you bring a photo/signature ID?** Whether you vote early or at the polls, you must present a form of valid ID. The most commonly used is a Florida driver's license. If you fail to bring ID, you will be asked to vote a Provisional Ballot. Your Voter Information card cannot be used for ID.
- **Do you need assistance voting?** You can bring a friend or relative, but our Patriot Poll Workers are well trained and qualified to assist you, too. All polling places also have electronic voting machines that allow most voters with disabilities to vote independently and in secret. Just ask!

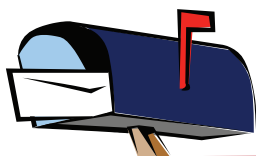

## **VOTE BY MAIL**

Move your polling place to your living room. Request your ballot by contacting the Supervisor of Elections office via telephone, email, mail, in person or by visiting our website. Order your absentee ballot today! Absentee ballots must be returned to the Supervisor of Elections office by 7pm on Election Day in order to be counted.



## **PRECINCT VOTING**

***Polls are open 7am - 7pm on Election Day!***

***August 14, 2012 Primary Election***

Be sure to bring a current and valid ID that includes your picture and signature for precinct and early voting! If the picture ID does not contain your signature, an additional ID that includes your signature shall be required. Approved forms of ID are:

- Florida Driver's License
- Florida ID Card issued by the Department of Highway Safety & Motor Vehicles
- Military ID
- Current U.S. Passport
- Debit/Credit Cards
- Student ID
- Retirement Center ID
- Neighborhood Association ID
- Public Assistance ID

## FLORIDA IS A CLOSED PRIMARY STATE



Florida is a closed primary state. Only the two major parties (Republican and Democratic) have primaries, which are nominating elections, and you have to be registered as a member of the party in whose primary you wish to vote.

Pursuant to a recent change in election law, registered minor parties are now eligible to have primaries also. However, all registered voters, regardless of party, vote in a primary on the nonpartisan races, such as School Board members, Judges, and referenda. The only exception to the closed primary is for a Universal Primary Contest.

## UNIVERSAL PRIMARY

You always get to vote on who holds office. By State Constitutional amendment in 1998, Florida created the Universal Primary Contest. If only people from one political party sign up to run for any particular office, then every voter gets a chance to vote in that race to decide who the winner will be - regardless of the voter's political party.

## PROVISIONAL BALLOTS

In order to ensure that no eligible voter is turned away, the law provides a method of voting for a person whose eligibility may be questioned at the polls. If no final determination can be made at the time of voting, or if the voter disagrees with a determination of eligibility, he or she may vote a provisional ballot. This ballot is secured in an envelope and the canvassing board will determine whether it is to be counted after research is completed by the elections office.

In addition, the voter has until 5 p.m. on the second day after the election to provide any further evidence he or she may have to prove his or her eligibility. All provisional voters are given written notice of free access to information on the disposition of his or her own provisional ballot.

**Please note: A voter who fails to bring photo and signature ID when voting is required by law to vote a provisional ballot. However, no further proof of eligibility is required by the voter. The voter's signature will be compared to the signature on file and counted if it matches. Voting by affirmation for lack of ID has been repealed.**

## OTHER IMPORTANT VOTING INFORMATION

### IDENTIFICATION

Voter Information cards are not a valid form of identification when voting. Photo and signature ID is required for voting. Approved forms of ID are:

- Florida ID Card issued by the Department of Highway Safety & Motor Vehicles
- Military ID
- Current U.S. Passport
- Debit/Credit Cards
- Student ID
- Retirement Center ID
- Neighborhood Association ID
- Public Assistance ID

### ADDRESS CHANGE

If you have moved recently and have a new address other than the one in the poll register, you will be asked to see the Clerk to determine if you are in the correct precinct. It is a third-degree felony to vote in a precinct other than which you live.

If you are asked to go to another precinct, you will be given a special form to take with you so the Clerk at the new precinct won't have to call the office. If you'd like to verify your address with our office before Election Day, just call, email us or use our online voter registration status lookup tool.

### NEED ASSISTANCE AT THE POLLS?

Need assistance to vote? You can bring a friend or family member, but poll workers are all trained and qualified to assist as well.

All polling places are accessible to voters with special needs and touch screen voting machines are available for voters with disabilities to vote secretly and independently as well.

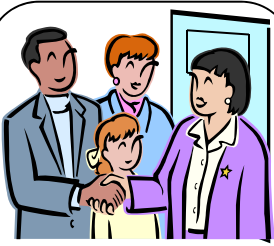

## WHAT TO EXPECT AT THE POLLS



### THE BAILIFF

I'm a special deputy who will greet you at the door and provide assistance when needed. I'll remind you to have your ID ready!



### THE GREETER

I'm especially helpful to first-time voters, giving ballot demonstrations and answering most questions. I even have special ballots for the kids too!



### BOOK INSPECTOR

I have the poll register with your name in it. I'll ask for your ID and check your signature before giving you a ballot ticket. I should never tell you that you can't vote!



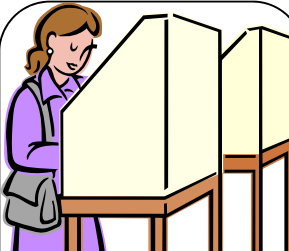
### BALLOT INSPECTOR

I take your ballot ticket and give you your ballot. I will say out loud which party ballot you're getting. Then I'll point your way to the voting booth.



### THE TOUCH SCREEN

The law now requires each precinct to have a touch screen voting machine for voters with special needs. Each precinct has one poll worker just to run it.



### VOTE!

Vote your secret ballot in the booth provided. ***If you make a mistake please ask for a new ballot!*** All done? Put your ballot in the folder and head for the Accu-Vote machine.



### BALLOT BOX INSPECTOR

I stand near the ballot box to assist voters should a problem arise. If one does, I can always call the clerk!



### NEED ASSISTANCE?

If you have any special needs that will make your voting experience easier and faster, just ask! There are plenty of friendly poll workers waiting to help!



### THE CLERK

I'm in charge of the precinct. If you have any questions or need extra assistance, I'll be happy to help. There's no problem I can't solve!



### SOLICITATION

Equally popular and unpopular, the law no longer allows any form of solicitation within 100 feet of your polling place.



### THANK YOU!

After you slide your ballot into the top of the Accu-Vote tabulator you're finished! Don't leave without your "I Voted" sticker and wear it proudly!
