

# NOTICE OF SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION CITY OF DESTIN, FLORIDA

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the City of Destin will hold a special election on Tuesday, July 20, 2021, for the following office:

**CITY COUNCIL, ONE SEAT: for the remaining term through November 21, 2022**

Candidates must be qualified electors and residents of the City of Destin for at least one year prior to the first day of qualifying. Candidates are elected at large, by highest number of votes.

An abbreviated qualifying period was held Monday, May 24, 2021, to Wednesday, May 26, 2021, at the Supervisor of Elections offices. In accordance with F.S. 99.061(8), the Supervisor's office was able to accept and hold qualifying papers submitted not earlier than 14 days prior to the beginning of the qualifying period, to be processed and filed during the qualifying period.

To qualify, a candidate must have filed the required papers and a nominating petition signed by twenty-five (25) qualified electors of the City of Destin. There was a \$25 qualifying fee, set by the city charter to be paid by a campaign account check. No election assessment is applicable under s.99.093 Florida Statutes.

Registration books for this election will close on Monday, June 21, 2021. Voting will be held for residents of the City of Destin at **Precinct 20** (Destin Community Center, 101 Stahlman Ave), **Precinct 35/44** (Corpus Christi Catholic Church, 307 Beach Dr), and **Precinct 50** (Destin City Hall Annex, 4100 Indian Bayou Trl), on Tuesday, July 20, 2021, from 7 am to 7 pm. Voting will be conducted in compliance with Americans with Disabilities Act; for information or assistance, call 850-651-7272.

Vote-by-mail ballots will be available through the Supervisor of Elections offices, in compliance with state and federal laws.
