Vote-by-mail ballots must be returned to the Supervisor of Elections Office by 7pm on Election Day in order to be counted.
-  **Early voting** will be held Monday, March 5 – Friday, March 9, at the Supervisor of Elections Offices in Crestview and Shalimar. Hours of operation are 8:30 am – 4:30 pm.
-  Your polling place at First Baptist Church, 28 North Street, Mary Esther, will be open from 7am to 7pm on March 13, 2018, Election Day.
