PLEASE NOTE that only residents of the Ocean City-Wright Fire Control District (Pcts 10, 16, 17, 18, 27, 29 [part only], 31, 37, 38, 39, and 42 [part only]) who are registered to vote **no later than February 13, 2006**, are eligible to vote in the designated elections on March 14, 2006.

If you have moved since you last voted or since you last had contact with our office, please check with the Supervisor of Elections office to verify if you are still eligible for these elections.

Polling places will be open from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. on election day, March 14. Polling places and **voting equipment** are accessible to the disabled and assistance is provided as needed.

Absentee ballots must be returned to the Supervisor of Elections office at 1804 Lewis Turner Blvd (Suite 404), Fort Walton Beach, no later than 7 p.m. on election day to be counted. Absentee ballots may **NOT** be turned in at any polling place, unless voter wishes to void the ballot and vote at the polls.
